News from CTC!

Did you Know...

CTC is one of a very few privately-run, nonprofit ferry companies in the US. We do not qualify for most transportation assistance and receive no subsidies from any local, state or federal government. Most ferry companies receive up to 50% of funding for operations from federal and state grants and up to 100% for capital projects, such as new boat construction!

- CTC continues to provide emergency transport on and off of the Island at no cost to the Town or patients, just as we've done for decades. The cost to CTC to provide this service to our community averages around \$25,000 per year.
- Week Day School CTC works with the Chebeague Island Council to provide free transportation to people receiving on-going medical treatment, such as physical therapy or chemotherapy. Please contact the Council for more information.
 - CTC provides free parking and ferry transportation apwhen funerals or memorial services are held on Chebeague or elsewhere for someone who is to be interred on Chebeague.
